The Tom Gibson Memorial Award was established in 1996 by the Universities of Strathclyde and Glasgow, with the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Glasgow and the British Association of Plastic Surgeons, to commemorate Professor Tom Gibson, a pioneer of plastic surgery and bioengineering and a co-founder of Strathclyde's bioengineering unit.

The award was established to recognise the outstanding contribution of a young medic or scientist; the 2016/17 award winner is [Dr Brian Patton](#) of the Department of Physics, whose research focuses on exploiting the properties of diamonds.
