#### Date/Time

The PG conference will take place via Zoom on Wednesday 18th August.

It will consist of two parallel sessions. Links to the sessions and a conference programme/timetable will be issued ahead of the conference.

#### **Title & Abstract submission**

- Go to the "Physics PhD students" MyPlace page.
- In the section titled "Postgraduate Conference (1st year PhD)" click on "Title and abstract submission" link/assignment.
- Enter your name, 1st supervisor name, talk title and brief abstract (~100 words max.) in the textbox as instructed, and submit.
- Please submit your title/abstract by Monday 16th August...

## Talk preparation

- Each talk will be allocated 12 minutes (pre-recorded) + 3 minutes (live) for questions.
- Your 12-minute talk should be recorded in advance in a standard video format e.g. MP4.
- The format of the talk should be PPT/Keynote/PDF slides with audio commentary.
- There are several options for how to produce your recorded talk e.g.
  - Add narration to a PPT presentation and save as .mp4 file
  - <u>Use Zoom to make a cloud recording</u> and <u>save it as an .mp4 file</u> (or create a link by sharing the recording (ensure password protection is off))
  - Use screen capture software such as <u>Screencast-o-matic</u> or similar.
- Create a link to your mp4 file (e.g. in <u>Onedrive</u>, <u>Strathcloud</u>, Dropbox etc.)

### Talk submission

- Go to the "Physics PhD students" page on MyPlace
- In the section titled "Postgraduate Conference (1st year PhD)" click on the "Talk submission" link/assignment.
- Enter the link to your mp4 file and submit.
- Please submit your talk by Monday 16th August.
