Work Task Identification and Evaluation of Associated Risks Visitors present in laboratory

Hazards Identified

Infection with Covid-19 by airborne transmission or contaminated surfaces.

Who might be harmed and how?

Staff, Students Extending tight 'bubble' of lab workers to include visitors increases risk of infection spread Similar risk pertains to visitors

Existing Risk Control Measures

1) Visitors required to wear face coverings 2) Visitors reminded of following social distancing 3) Visitors to be direct to hand washing or sanitizer supplies on entry/exit to lab. 4) Visitors required to withdraw if they are subject to self isolation requirements 5) Visitors are registered with the University for track and trace purposes 6) Visitors are obligated to inform the lab, or the University for centrally hosted events, should they develop symptoms within 10 days of the visit. University/lab mutually obligated to advise visitors of any symptoms developing in 10 days amongst any hosts.

Likelihood: 2:unlikely **Severity:** 4:major **Risk Rating:** medium



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7) Staff to observe strict social distancing
8) Staff identified as vulnerable not to be asked to host visitors
9) Numbers of staff hosting visitors to be minimised
10) Justification for visit to be measured against protection level in current force and prevalence of virus
11) likelyhood to be adjusted as appropriate to current prevalence and protection level in RH column
