

Call for 2022 content proposals

The Institute of Physics' annual community science festival the Big Bounce is now welcoming proposals for exciting and impactful family content for the 29 and 30 October 2022 in the East End of Glasgow.

As part of the <u>Limit Less campaign</u>, the festival aims to influence the parents and carers of diverse young people that are underrepresented in physics – in this case, those from households in the local area that experience high levels of socio-economic deprivation. By showing parents that young people can change the world by doing physics no matter where they come from, we help them to pass on this message at home.

To do this, the Big Bounce creates an inspiring and enjoyable celebration of physics and its real-world superpowers. This 2-minute snapshot video from 2021 gives a feel of the 2022 festival.



As part of the 2022 programme, we are again looking for third-party content suitable for our family audience. This could be workshops, shows, drop-in activities, digital experiences, or anything else that celebrates physics!
