RISE GERMANY / RISE PROFESSIONAL – RESEARCH INTERNSHIPS IN SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING

For Undergraduates and Graduates

- Research internships for students from British and Irish universities in the field of biology, chemistry, computer science, physics, earth science, engineering or a closely related field
- Candidates are matched with German companies and with non-university research institution that have strong links with industry
- German language requirements vary according to the internship placement
- RISE Germany: For undergraduates
- RISE Professional: For MA and PhD students

UNIVERSITY SUMMER COURSES FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS AND GRADUATES

For Undergraduates and Graduates

- This program provides scholarships to attend a broad range of three- to four-week summer courses at German universities which focus mainly on German language and literary, cultural, political and economic aspects of modern and contemporary Germany.

- Financial support for subject-related academic information visits to Germany organized by faculty members for groups of students.
- Group Study Visit grants are intended to encourage contact with academic institutions, groups and individuals in Germany, and offer insight into current issues in the academic, scientific, economic, political and cultural realms.

DAAD RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS

For students in the UK and Ireland

- Research grants One-year grant
- Research grants Bi-nationally supervised doctoral degrees
- Research grants Short-term grants

Please note: To apply through the DAAD London Office, you should have been resident in the UK or Ireland for at least one year.

Other DAAD scholarships might be available if you are resident in another country.



DAAD – ONE YEAR GRANT FOR DOCTORAL STUDENTS

- Funding for a research project at a state-run or state-recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany
- 7 12 months of funding
- Usually aimed at excellently-qualified doctoral candidates / PhD students
- Grant includes a monthly payment, insurance, travel allowance, and a one-off research allowance, as well as potential other subsidies depending on circumstances
- Deadline: December for a funding start in October of the next year



DAAD – ONE YEAR GRANTS FOR BI-NATIONALLY SUPERVISED DEGREES (OR COTUTELLE)

Funding of bi-national doctoral projects at the home university and at a university in Germany

- "Sandwich Model": The doctoral project is supervised both by a university teacher at the home university and an academic adviser at the host institute in Germany; the project must be coordinated with both supervisors. Doctoral candidates start their doctoral degree in their home country but subsequently spend research periods in Germany. The doctorate is completed in the home country with participation of the German academic adviser; the doctoral degree is awarded by the home university.
- Cotutelle option: similar, but the doctoral degree will be awarded by both institutions (UK/Ireland and Germany) and a formal contract between the universities exists.
- Maximum of 24 months of funding



DAAD SHORT TERM RESEARCH GRANTS

Funding for a research project at a state-run or state-recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany

- 1 6 months of funding
- Aimed at excellently-qualified doctoral candidates / PhD students/ PostDocs
- Grant includes a monthly payment insurance, travel allowance as well as potential other subsidies depending on circumstances
- ⇒ Next deadline: **15.02.2023** for mobilities between August March 2024
- Usually two deadlines p.a.: February and September, please check DAAD London website for updates on deadlines



POSTDOC FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

- DAAD PRIME (Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience): 18-month employment contract at a German university to conduct a 12-month research stay abroad with a subsequent return phase to Germany. During the 12 months abroad, a combination of stays at several research institutions in one or several countries.
- DAAD Research Stays for University Academics and Scientists
- DLR-DAAD Research Fellowship Programme (DLR = "German Aerospace Centre"); disciplines: Aeronautics, Space, Energy, Transportation, Digitalisation, Security
