The John Anderson Façade and Building Services improvement works.

This project has been funded through the Scottish Funding Council's (SFC) University Financial Transactions Programme (UFTP). The project is part of the University's net zero pathway programme in alignment with our Strategic Plan (Strathclyde 2030) to reduce carbon emissions as part of our Key Performance Indicator (KPI) 16.

Building fabric and services improvements will be in progress from January until the end of August 2025. These high priority projects are key to the successful delivery of our net zero pathway to achieve the mandated targets. This project will improve the energy performance of John Anderson Building by reducing its current heat loss and will improve the building fabric and air permeability.

This project involves the installation of over cladding the external fabric of John Anderson Building including replacement of the existing windows to all facades on the building. The specification will meet current regulations for thermal and sound control and will reduce the heat loss within the building. The existing heating and ventilation systems in the building will be replaced on levels 4 to 8.
