Water Efficiency Fund | Applications open from Tuesday, 1 April

I'm pleased to let you know that the Public Sector Scotland (PSS) Water Efficiency Fund will be open for applications from **Tuesday**, **1 April 2025**.

The Water Efficiency Fund has been set up to encourage public bodies across Scotland to deliver water efficiency projects while recognising the environmental and associated financial benefits of doing so.

Business Stream contribution

To support our commitment to make a positive difference, we're allocating £100,000 to the PSS Water Efficiency Fund for 2025/26. This contribution will be used to support the water efficiency projects selected by the Fund Allocation Panel and we're encouraging all of our public sector customers to apply, including previously successful candidates.

Water Efficiency Fund 2024/25 - success stories

Since 2020, we've provided funding to **38 water efficiency projects** across the public sector, totalling **£300,000**. Some organisations that benefitted from last year's funding include:

- Renfrewshire Council received £17,800 to invest in hydrotherapy pool covers at Riverbrae Additional Support Needs School.
- The Highland Council received £10,000 to invest in a public convenience water efficiency project at their sites.
- Aberdeenshire Council received £9,700 to install sensors and urinal flush controls at 10 of their public toilets.
- Moray Council received £4,000 to install solenoid valves for toilets to control the flow of water at Anderson Primary School.
